# facilities & efficiency

Has the building been certified as green by a third party? Which one?\_\_\_\_\_

Can the venue accommodate both ceremony and reception (on purpose to minimize the carbon emissions)?

Do you use alternative sources of energy to make electricity? Which ones?\_\_\_\_\_

Do you use geothermal power for cooling and heating? Are there low-flow toilets and other water-saving devices in restrooms? Are there any eco-friendly means to dry hands in restrooms, like cloth napkins, 100% recycled paper towels or low energy hand dryers?\_\_\_\_\_ Does the venue purchases environmentally responsible cleaning products? Do you care how far away the products you buy need to be shipped? How far away the products you use come from? Does the venue use sustainable couriers and transport?\_\_\_\_\_ What does the venue do to reduce energy use?\_\_\_\_\_ Is it possible to hold the wedding during the day to save on electric power?\_\_\_\_\_ Are there a lot of windows to let the natural light in?\_\_\_\_\_ Can windows be opened for natural ventilation?\_\_\_\_\_ Do you have energy-efficient lighting (for example, LED lighting)? Is it allowed to use candles (candlelight)?\_\_\_\_\_ Do you use appliences carrying a label for energy efficiency (for example, Energy Star seal)?

Is the coffee and tea you serve fair-trade? Will the beverages be served from pitchers instead of individual bottles or cans?

Are the drinks you serve locally made and/or fair-trade (for example, locally made beer, Fare Trade vine or juice made from local seasonal fruits)?\_\_\_\_\_\_

Do you wash your own linens to avoid cleaning services that use bleach and other nasty chemicals?

Are your linens made from organic cotton?\_\_\_\_\_

Are napkins you use reusable or recycled and recyclable or compostable?

If composting is available, what can be composted?\_\_\_\_\_

What happens with leftovers? Can they be given for clients to take away in compostable containers or donated to farmers to feed to animals, for example?\_\_\_\_\_\_
